Assessment, Case Conceptualization, Diagnosis, and ...

Diagnosis is the identification of a problem which becomes the target of the counseling intervention Treatment planning provides a road map for the counseling process Treatment plans identify what the professional counselor and client are going to work on together and what strategies will be used to achieve these goals Assessment
