Such examinations are usually referred to as fitness-for-duty examinations (FFDs) within the Postal Service FFDs for work-related injuries or illnesses are covered by Section 54562 of the ELM It states in part that a "fitness-for-duty examination is not limited to the employee's regular duties, but should be based on whether the employ-
