With drop handlebars the shift levers are the same levers you use to apply your brakes, to shift gears you push the lever sideways until you hear a click. For mountain and hybrid style bikes with flat bars, you shift the gears via thumb triggers, completely separate from your braking system.

### Shifting 101 - A How To Guide on Shifting Bike Gears ...

On the floor, you will see three pedals to choose from. The left pedal is the clutch pedal, the middle pedal is the brake pedal, and the right pedal is the gas pedal. You press the clutch pedal with your left foot prior to shifting gears. When you press the clutch pedal, it disconnects the engine from the gearbox.

To operate the shifters you push the lever sideways until you hear a click. For most mountain and hybrid style bikes with flat bars, you shift the gears by using set paddles that you operate with your thumb. Some bikes operate with "grip shifters", or a dial that is located to the inside of where you place your hands.

Turn the key in the ignition and shift to first gear. Start your car and wait for the engine to roll over. Make sure you keep the clutch depressed with your left foot. Use the shifter on your right side to transition into first gear.

Most systems have three gears on the front, which are controlled by your left shifter. The rear gear cluster usually has 7 gears, with some systems having 8 or 9. Not to worry, the concepts here are the same. For most everyday riding, you'll want to keep your chain on the middle ring on the front, or number 2 on your left shifter.

Loosen your cable adjuster if the chain won't shift down. If you have trouble shifting as you lower your gears (lower gears are closer to the wheel), then loosen the cable adjuster by turning it counterclockwise. Turn the adjuster slowly, turning until the chain falls into the correct gear.

Roll the throttle closed with your right hand. Pull the clutch lever in with your left hand. Shift up into the next higher gear with your left foot. As before, you should feel the transmission click into gear.

### How to shift gears on a motorcycle - RevZilla

Use the color indicators on the tachometer. Most RPM gauges should be color-coded, with 1500 rpms at about the top (12 o'clock) of the gauge, which is typically colored green. This is the ideal place to shift between gears. 1700-2100 is typically beyond the point where you should be shifting, with the exception of going downhill.
